Dear Artist,

I am writing to extend my invitation to the ARISIA Art Show, returning on the weekend of January 14-17, 2011. Our Artist Guest of Honour this year is Josh Simpson, and at least 2,600 science fiction and fantasy fans will be in attendance. We have a **new** hotel this year, the Westin Waterfront Hotel, Boston MA, which has quite a bit more space!

Each year, in addition to displaying an extensive collection of works by our Guest of Honor, we mount other exhibits and coordinate events, including docent tours, to draw traffic to the Art Show. One example is an expanded Artist & Author Alley which you may want to check out as well; we will also be sharing space in the Galleria with the Vendors' area and will have a large costume exhibit nearby which will draw foot traffic.

We will once again feature a Quicksale option, proxy bids and noregistration bidding; however, we will return to the live auction as we will now space for an auction room. You will be able to pick up unsold art between 8pm and 10pm on Sunday or between 10am and 2pm on Monday. In recent years we have had checks available for some artists by Monday morning, and the rest go out within two weeks of the show.

If you are unable to attend ARISIA 'II, an agent may represent you, with written authorization from you. Mailed-in art will also be accepted; there is an additional handling fee of \$15 per artist for mailed-in art.
